General Primary School Supplies

- Backpacks: Students may carry any kind of backpack they choose (no character backpacks, please). Since primary students do not bring home textbooks every night, it need not be large. In fact, the larger ones, particularly the ones with wheels, are heavier than the contents and much more cumbersome to carry up and down stairs.
- Labels: Label your child's art box with his first and last name. Watercolors, scissors, and erasers can be marked with initials. No other items need to be labeled.
- Some supplies will be provided by the school, such as journals, homework folders, pencil sharpeners and whiteboards.
- Please bring your supplies on Meet the Teacher Day to avoid having so much to carry on the first day. The art box should be packed with unwrapped crayons, scissors, colored pencils and erasers. All other supplies will be collected as "community supplies".
- Please do not send extra supplies that are not listed.

Junior Kindergarten & Kindergarten

Art Box: plastic; snaps shut; small size (apprx.8"x5") NO BIGGER please... tables and cubbies are small! Please do not decorate boxes with stickers or other objects.

Glue Sticks: dries clear, qty 4

Liquid Glue: 1 bottle Elmer's

Crayons: 24 pack of Crayola

Scissors: Metal blade, blunt end

Watercolor set: Crayola; 16 or 24 colors

Colored Pencils: 24 pack of Crayola (Kindergarten only)

Dry Erase Markers: broad tip; dark color; qty 4

Erasers: 2 large pink (Kindergarten only)

Index Cards: 1 package blank 3 x 5 cards

Sock: for white board eraser

Other: 2 boxes of tissues and 1 bottle of hand sanitizer

Please label all items marked * with your student's name. All items marked ☺ will be collected as "community" supplies. Please do not bring larger quantities or extra supplies that aren't listed since our storage space is limited. It would help our first day of school to start more smoothly if you would bring all supplies (labeled!) to the Meet the Teacher Day. Thank You!

- Large back pack*
- A sturdy, 1 ½ inch, 3-ring binder (for all subjects)
This will be kept at home to store returned quizzes, tests and other assignments. It is the responsibility of the student (with parental aid!) to file all returned paper in this binder for future use.
- 8 dividers for use in the 3-ring binder
Labeled: Latin, Math, Literature, Language Arts, Classical, Christian, Astronomy, and American
- Flashcards: Addition & Multiplication (also kept at home; will be used regularly for HW)
- 3 spiral notebooks (70 pages, wide rule)
 - 1 RED, labeled Latin*
 - 1 YELLOW, labeled Math*
 - 1 GREEN, labeled Grammar*
- 2 pocket folders (with horizontal pockets):
 - 1 sturdy plastic, BLUE* (this will travel back & forth daily)
 - 1 any color/design/type* (this will stay at school in their desk)
- 1 supply box (small size 8"x5")*
(NO BIGGER please, desks are small!)
- Watercolors (16 or 24 count)*;

4th Grade

Please label all items marked \$ with your name. All items marked # will be collected as community supplies. Also, it would help our first day of school to start more smoothly if you would bring all supplies (labeled!) to Meet the Teacher Day. If you can't come that day, bring them the first day of class. Please bring *only* the necessary supplies to school. Other supplies will be provided by the school (e.g. planner).

- 1 yellow spiral-bound, wide ruled, single subject notebook
- 1 red (color preferred, not required) steno notebook \$
- 1 sturdy 2 inch binder (used for all subjects)
This will be kept at school to store quizzes, tests, and other assignments. Graded assignments will be sent home in the students' 1 inch binder. They will then be sent back to school the following day. It is the responsibility of students to file these graded assignments in their binder at school. The students are always welcome to take home old tests and quizzes to study for cumulative tests. It is important for students to learn this responsibility.
- 8 dividers for binder that will be kept at school. Label the tabs as follows: Latin, Math, English Lit., Language Arts, FMR, Geography, Christian Studies, Science.

5th Grade

Please bring all supplies on Meet the Teacher Day.

- 3 1-1/2 inch white view binders-with insertable clear pockets on the outside

- One 2 inch binder with 7 pocket dividers labeled as follows: Math, Literature, Language Arts, American Studies, Classical Studies, Christian Studies, and Science

This binder will remain at home for the students' use in filing tests, handouts, etc. after we have finished them in class. These papers will come home with students in their "To be Filed" folder.

- 1 folder with pockets labeled as follows: The left pocket should be labeled "Homework." The right pocket should be labeled "To be Filed." This folder will travel between school and home. All homework should be placed in the "Homework" pocket and returned to school with the student. 6th Grade

- 2 sturdy 2 inch binders with 7 pocket dividers each labeled as follows: Math, Science, Language Arts, Christian Studies, English, Classical Studies, and American Studies

One of these binders will remain at home for the student's use in filing tests, handouts, etc. after we have finished them in class. These papers will come home with students in their "To be Filed" folder.

- 1 folder with pockets labeled as follows: The left pocket should be labeled "Homework." The right pocket should be labeled "To be Filed." This folder will travel between school and home. Grades 7-12

Students will need 3 ring binders for their subjects. It is preferable to have a separate ½” to 1” binder for core subjects (Math, Science, Latin, English, and U.S. History) but you may also combine subjects according to teacher or days of the week. Regardless of whether you have separate binders or combined binders, each subject should have a pocket and dividers for 3 sections: one for notes and homework, one for tests and quizzes, and one for handouts. *This is not a complete list. Particular supply needs for individual subjects and teachers may be requested after school begins.*

Students also need:

- Pens
- Pencils (for Math)
- Highlighters
- One spiral bound graph notebook, 4x4 quad ruled
- Notebook paper, college ruled
- Standard metric ruler (non-bendable)
- One box of Kleenex
- **8th Grade Science:** Standard calculator
- **Pre-Cal and Calculus:** TI 83 or 84 Calculator. These calculators can often be found used on sites such as Amazon.com at a much reduced rate.
- **7th and 8th Grade Literature/Composition:** Composition notebook (non-spiral)
- **Biology:** Colored pencils (12 pack) and index cards (qty 200)
- **Mrs. Luoma’s Latin Classes:** Index cards (qty 400)
- **7th Grade Classical Studies:** Folder *only* (binder and notebook *not* necessary)

There are some items that are helpful to have at home, though not required:

- 3-hole punch
- Hole reinforcements
- Index cards
- Stapler
- whiteout
